Term 1 Course Descriptions

Advanced Anatomy & Physiology (I) *7

Onsite Schedule: Mondays, 12:30 – 3:00pm

Distance Hours: 4.5 Hours per week

Pre-requisite: Anatomy & Physiology (II)

Advancing further into study of the body, you will begin to appreciate the body as a complex network. Focus of this course is in-depth study of the musculoskeletal anatomy, including muscles, bones and ligaments.

Clinical Massage Theory & Practice (I) *5

Onsite Schedule: Mondays, 10:00 – 11:30am
Wednesdays, 12:30 – 2:00pm

Distance Hours: 2 Hours per week

Pre-requisite: Assessment & Case Management

Continuing with client studies, you will focus on integration of intake, assessment & treatment planning. Further to basic skills in client relation and communication, you will develop advanced assessment techniques, massage techniques & treatment planning, advanced charting & client follow-up and scope of practice & client referrals.

Conscious Communication & Practice (III) *3

Onsite Schedule: Wednesdays, 2:15 – 3:45pm

Distance Hours: 1.5 Hours per week

Pre-requisite: Conscious Communication & Practice (II)

As self-awareness and development grows, we will address the study of neuro-anatomy & its relation to individual experience. Furthering our studies is the focus on client communication skills (verbal & non-verbal) as well as personal intuition, perception & actuality.

Pathology & Kinesiology *7

Onsite Schedule: Wednesdays, 10:00 – 11:30am

Distance Hours: 5.5 Hours per week

This introductory study of Pathology & Kinesiology is approached in terms of treating the body as a whole. Studies in nutrition will also be addressed and include nutritional requirements, deficiencies and metabolism.

Therapeutic Massage & Exercise *7

Onsite Schedule: Fridays, 10:00 – 11:30am and 12:30 - 4:00pm

Distance Hours: 2 hours

Pre-requisite: Relaxation Massage & Spa Techniques (II)

Learning by doing is the approach in this hands-on course, which will introduce new therapeutic treatment techniques. The focus is on developing outcome-based treatments, and addresses numerous orthopaedic treatments, as well as providing techniques/approaches to pain & stress management.

Advanced Musculoskeletal Anatomy *7

Onsite Schedule: Wednesdays, 10:00 – 11:30am
Distance Hours: 5.5 Hours per week
Pre-requisite: Advanced Anatomy & Physiology (III)

Further to your advanced studies in anatomy & physiology, this course will provide you with in-depth knowledge of musculoskeletal anatomy including muscle origins & insertions and body landmarks. Focus in this course is hands-on understanding of musculoskeletal anatomy.

Conscious Communication & Practice (IV) *3

Onsite Schedule: Mondays, 2:45 – 4:15pm
Distance Hours: 1.5 Hours per week
Pre-requisite: Conscious Communication & Practice (III)

A consciousness-based approach to the Massage Therapy profession includes personal, professional and community development. In this course, we will address professional conduct & strategies for problem resolution. Expanding our scope, we will address business practices & development, as well as community development & maintenance.
